

Coronavirus:

How everyone can stay safe during prison visits

Adult prisons

To help keep everyone safe from coronavirus, there are some changes



Staff know that this is a very difficult time for you. But it is important that you understand and follow the rules.

Visitors must be:

- At least 18 years old (unless they are with an adult)
- A partner, parent, fosterparent, grandparent, carer, significant other, or someone who provides emotional support



Visitors must live together as part of the same household unless they are parents who live apart.





 Two adults can visit at the same time

or

One adult and two children

or

Two adults and one child

Children can only visit if they are the child of someone in prison or dependent on them.



During visits you must:

- Stay over two metres away from other people, with no physical contact
- Wear a face covering, but you must remove it for security checks



You may be able to take off your face covering if it is possible to stay two metres away from your visitors. Staff will tell you if you can do this.

Play facilities will not be available.
